Reference is made to the above mentioned project located at or near Section 33, T4N, R71W, Larimer County, Colorado.

If any work requires the discharge of dredged or fill material, and any excavation associated with a dredged or fill project, either temporary or permanent in wetlands, this office should be notified by a proponent of the project for Department of the Army permits, changes in permit requirements or jurisdictional determinations pursuant to Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.

Work in an aquatic site should be identified by the proponent of the project and be shown on a map identifying the Quarter Section, Township, Range and County, Latitude and Longitude in Decimal Degrees (example 39.55555; -104.55555) and the dimensions of work in each aquatic site. Any loss of an aquatic site may require mitigation. Mitigation requirements will be determined during the Department of the Army permitting review.
