On October 18, 2013 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (DRMS) received The Liberty Mining, LLC 110d Hard Rock, Metals and Designated Mining Operation Application package for the Liberty Mine, File No. M-2013-070. Preliminary review of the information received determined that the following items must be received before the Division can consider your application as being submitted and technical review can begin:

APPLICATION FORM: An application form must accompany the supporting application materials in order for the application to be considered complete. Please send the original completed application form along with a complete copy of the supporting application materials to the Denver DRMS Office and a copy of the completed application form to the DRMS Grand Junction Field Office. Enclosed is the application form that must be signed and notarized.

APPLICATION FEE: The application cannot be considered complete without the required application fee. Please send a check in the amount of \$2875.00 to the DRMS Denver Office

Your application will not be considered filed until the information listed above is received and found sufficient to begin our review. A decision date will be established 30 days from the date of receipt of all of the requested information.

You have sixty (60) days from the above date to submit all necessary documents that the Office needs for an application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the sixty day period, the application has not been determined to be filed with the Office, the Office shall deny the application and terminate the application file.

This letter shall not be construed to mean that there are no other technical deficiencies in your application. The Division will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
