Re: Currier Gravel Pit, Permit M-1980-203, Review of Current Permit Status.

Ms. Currier:

On October 29, 2013, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (DRMS) received information regarding the land dispute between Currier Gravel Pit, Inc. (Operator) and the Bureau of Land Management (BLM). The DRMS requires the following information / materials:

- Please provide an updated map that shows the BLM lands that are within the approved reclamation permit area.
- Please supply proof that the Operator has the right to enter the BLM lands within the approved reclamation permit area.
- Provide a timeframe that reclamation will occur within the reclamation permit area. If reclamation is not to start prior to summer 2014 the Operator shall file for Temporary Cessation status.

Furthermore, if any mining is proposed to take place outside of the currently approved reclamation permit area the Operator must submit an amendment to the DRMS. The Operator must obtain approval and permit issuance from the DRMS before any new mining activities occur.
