Dear Sir or Madam:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has received a revision for the West Elk Mine. The revision was deemed complete on November 4, 2013. The decision due date is November 14, 2013.

The Mountain Coal Company, LLC has submitted a Minor Revision to the West Elk Mine's permit. The revision proposes to eliminate the lower portion of the half-culvert RPEE ditch that flows into the RPE Pond. This lower portion of the half-culvert will be replaced with a compact clay and riprap lined ditch of the same dimensions as the current half-culvert. Mountain Coal is proposing the ditch segment to help secure the end of the half-culvert and dissipate flows from the half-culvert prior to water entering the pond. There is no proposed increase in the mine's permitted or disturbed boundaries as a result of this revision. Since there is already a liability cost included in the mine's reclamation cost estimate for the removal of the half-culvert, there will be no increase in the mine's reclamation liability as a result of the changes proposed in this revision.
