We received your letter dated October 2, 2013, notifying the Corps of Engineers that you have signed and transferred the Standard Permit for project SPK 2007-02172, North Bank Gravel Pit, from Lafarge NA, Incorporated. We are also aware that Lafarge did not fully impact the wetlands proposed at Mine Cell B, before the permit authorization expired on November 20, 2012. We understand, at some point, you desire to re-apply to the Corps of Engineers for authorization to impact wetlands at Mine Cell B. The project site is located on the Colorado River within Section 12, Township 6 S, Range 93 W, Sixth Principal Meridian, Latitude 39.5408°, Longitude -107.7248°, Garfield County, Colorado.
