At the north edge of the disturbance boundary two rows of bales had been placed in such a way as to slow the flow of water through an area prone to erosion.

GENERAL MINE PLAN COMPLIANCE:

TR57 is in progress. The proposed decision due date has been extended to December 31, 2013. The Division is waiting on a response to the last adequacy review.

A letter was sent to NECC on October 30, 2013, giving notice that a complete application for Permit Renewal is required on or before December 24, 2013. This will be RN6.
