## **COMMENTS**

This was a partial inspection by Leigh Simmons of Colorado Division for Reclamation, Mining and Safety, (the Division). The inspection was accompanied by Bobby Steele of New Elk Coal Company, (NECC). The weather was foggy and cold.

Several permitting actions are in progress, these are detailed under the heading GENERAL MINE PLAN COMPLIANCE.

No further work had taken place at Lorencito Canyon since the October inspection as resources had been allocated at the New Elk mine. Mr Steele described plans to send people and equipment back to Lorencito in January/February to conduct rill and gully repair, and re-seed areas as necessary, other projects that suggest themselves include re-routing water flow from the road above the shrub plot and cleaning out sediment ponds as necessary. Erosion control on the slope above pond 6 is another project that should be tackled, although it is not presently clear how best to acheive this.

#### EXCESS SPOIL and DEVELOPMENT WASTE - Rule 4.09

Placement; Drainage Control; Surface Stabilization:

Fills 7, 8 and 9 were all stable and in good shape.

## HYDROLOGIC BALANCE - Rule 4.05

Ponds 9/9b, 6 and 8 were inspected. All ponds were in good shape; the water levels had dropped, but not yet sufficiently to assess whether or not the ponds need to be cleaned of sediment.

Pond 5 was difficult to access given the weather conditions, however the drainage area at the top was inspected and was adequate, although Elk had been nibbling at the bales.

Ponds 7 and 9a were not inspected.

The plan to route water running off the road through culvert C5 was discussed again and the intention was to go ahead.
