**Re: Hartman Pit – Right to Enter and Structures Agreement;  
Permit No. M-1997-087 / SO-03**

I have reviewed the October 31, 2013 "Access Agreement" and October 25, 2013 letter from Colorado Interstate Gas Company, LLC (CIG) regarding "Seeding and straw mulching on Colorado Interstate gas Company's easement in SE¼NW¼ of Section 24-21S-64W, Pueblo County, CO (Mining Permit M-1997-087).

The Access Agreement has been adequately modified to include the previously missing SW¼NE¼ of Section 20, T 21S, R 63W, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. and addresses "Any and all damages to Hartman's property or structures".

The letter from the CIG is inadequate for the following reasons:

- 1) The letter is not notarized as required by Rule 6.4.19(c),
- 2) The referenced location is 2 miles west of the Hartman pit and the wrong quarter/quarter section. The proper reference is the SW¼NE¼ of Section 20, T 21S, R 63W, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., not the SE¼NW¼ of Section 24, T 21S, R 64W, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M.,
- 3) Pursuant to Rule 6.4.19(c), the notarized letter must state: "that the mining and reclamation activities, as proposed, will have "no negative effect" on their utility".

The letter from CIG must be resubmitted with above corrections in order to be adequate.
