The request for a TR is not considered "filed for review" until the appropriate fee is received by the Division (as listed below by permit type). Please submit the appropriate fee with your request to expedite the review process. After the TR is submitted with the appropriate fee, the Division will determine if it is approvable within 30 days. If the Division requires additional information to approve a TR, you will be notified of specific deficiencies that will need to be addressed. If at the end of the 30 day review period there are still outstanding deficiencies, the Division must deny the TR unless the permittee requests additional time, in writing, to provide the required information.

There is no pre-defined format for the submittal of a TR; however, it is up to the permittee to provide sufficient information to the Division to approve the TR request, including updated mining and reclamation plan maps that accurately depict the changes proposed in the requested TR.

This letter is to request a Technical Revision to the permit for the following Mine:

J & P Trucking Pit #1 Mine ID#: M-2011-021

Please find the "Request for Technical Revision (TR) Cover Sheet" attached.

Components in this Technical Revision include the following:

- 1) Revisions to Exhibit D Mining Plan: Allow concurrent mining of phases; updated maps
- 2) Revising the number of phases: Addition of Phase 5
- 3) New structures agreement
- 4) Request Intermittent Status

1) Concurrent mining of phases:

J & P Trucking requests to revise Exhibit D – Mining Plan: to remove the requirement to complete all steps of reclamation in one mining phase prior to continuing to the next mining phase; and to request that J & P Trucking be allowed to mine phases concurrently. Currently, Phase 1 has been depleted of reserves sooner than anticipated, making it necessary to move on to Phase 2 prior to the complete reclamation of Phase 1. Some steps towards reclamation have already been initiated in one area in Phase 1. Also, there is a small amount of ground in Phase 1 that will be left unmined. To minimize the amount of affected acreage in other Phases, J & P Trucking requests to utilize approx. 5-6 acres within the boundaries of Phase 1 for stockpiling product to be sold. J & P Trucking commits to having disturbed no more than 15 acres at any given time. Please see attached map A indicating areas in Phase 1 proposed to be utilized for product stockpiling, undergoing steps toward reclamation, and left unmined; and proposed location of topsoil stockpiles in Phase 2.

2) Revising the number of phases - adding Phase 5:

J & P Trucking requests to revise the number of phases inside the permit boundary to include an additional phase of mining, to be mined concurrently with other phases. Phase 5 would be located East of Phases 1 & 2, and would be approx. 8 acres in area. Total affected area between all phases will be kept at 15 acres or less. Please see map B indicating proposed location of Phase 5 in relation to other phases, and map C, the reclamation plan map for Phase 5.

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3) New structures agreement:

J & P Trucking requests to revise Exhibit S – Permanent Man-Made Structures, to incorporate into the permit application an item meeting said criteria, and the attached notarized letter pertaining to said item:

A public, maintained county road, County Road G, along the North boundary of Phases 2 and 3, approximate location as depicted on Mining Phases maps in Exhibit C. Please see attached, notarized letter from Baca County District 2 Commissioner Peter Dawson.

4) Request Intermittent Status

J & P Trucking requests Intermittent Status for the above-referenced permit. This site has reserves remaining to be mined. Mining activities will occur for less than 180 days per calendar year due to Operator/Permittee having multiple business interests.
