In accordance with Rule 3.03.2(5)(b) of the Rules and Regulations of the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board for Coal Mining (Rules), you are hereby notified that the Division's decision to Approve Bond Release Application No. 13 for the New Horizon Mine became final on December 10, 2013.

Bond Release No. 13 reduces your reclamation liability by \$589,160.49. The current liability is now \$5,113,540.32. The Division suggests you provide a copy of this letter (and, for federal operations, copies of the OSM and BLM concurrence letters) to your bonding company for written evidence of approval to reduce your bond. If you choose to reduce or replace your existing bond, it must equal or exceed \$5,113,540.32. If this release constitutes a full and final bond release, the Division will return your performance bond to you as soon as possible.
