On December 11, 2013 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received a request for a Technical Revision (TR-69) addressing the following:

• Relocation of the radio relay tower from the South Cresson portion of the Main Cresson mining area to Squaw Mountain.

The submittal was called complete for the purpose of filing on December 13, 2013. The decision date for TR-69 is January 13, 2014. Please be advised that if you are unable to satisfactorily address any concerns identified in this review before the decision date, **it will be your responsibility to request an extension of the review period**. If there are outstanding issues that have not been adequately addressed prior to the end of the review period, and no extension has been requested, the Division will deny this technical revision.

The following comments are based on the Division's review of the TR-69 Request for Technical Revision:

- 1) <u>Drawing C-4</u>:
 - a. Please delineate the proposed new radio tower/access road disturbance area with the appropriate line type/color.
 - b. Please add the blue VLF delineation boundary to the drawing legend.
- Please note that the Division may grant a conditional approval for TR-69 requiring that CC&V provide documentation from Teller County demonstrating approval of this proposed disturbance inside the area of the Victor-Goldfield Buffer Agreement with Teller County.
- 3) The Division understands that this relocation is <u>not</u> related to the proposed radio tower shown on Drawing C-4 in the SW¹/₄, SW¹/₄ of Section 30 adjacent to HWY 67.
