NOTICE OF PROPOSED DECISION

The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety proposes to Approve with conditions Technical Revision Application No. 10 (TR-10) for the Hayden Gulch Loadout (Permit No. C-1992-081), submitted by Hayden Gulch Terminal, LLC. This Technical Revision provides permit updates required for permit renewal no. 4 (RN4).

The Hayden Gulch Loadout is a/an Loadout coal mine located in Routt County, approximately 2 miles SE of Hayden, Colorado. Coal interest is Federal, state and private, and the surface affected is State and private land. The permit area encompasses approximately 391.20 acres.

This proposed decision is based on a finding that the proposed operation will comply with all requirements of the Colorado Surface Coal Mining Reclamation Act, Section 34-33-101, *et seq.*, C.R.S., and the regulations promulgated thereunder.
