OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the normal monitoring program established by the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division). The K-T Pit is located approximately 5 miles southeast of Meeker, Colorado. The site is a 110c construction materials operation that includes 9.90 acres with a maximum allowed disturbance of 2.50 acres. Amber Shults representing #17 Enterprises, LLC was present during the inspection.

The required mine identification sign and boundary markers were in place and in compliance with Rule 3.1.12. The permit boundary markers were comprised of fences and fence posts around the entire perimeter of the mine.

Stockpiles of various construction materials were observed at the site. No active mining was occurring during the inspection due to the inclement weather. The site was free of any uncessary debris and appeared to be well kept.

A required routine reclamation cost update will be conducted and sent under separate cover.

No problems or possible were observed during the inspection.
