The Division is charged with determining if the revision as submitted meets this definition. If the Division determines that the proposed revision is beyond the scope of a TR, the Division may require the submittal of a permit amendment to make the required or desired changes to the permit.

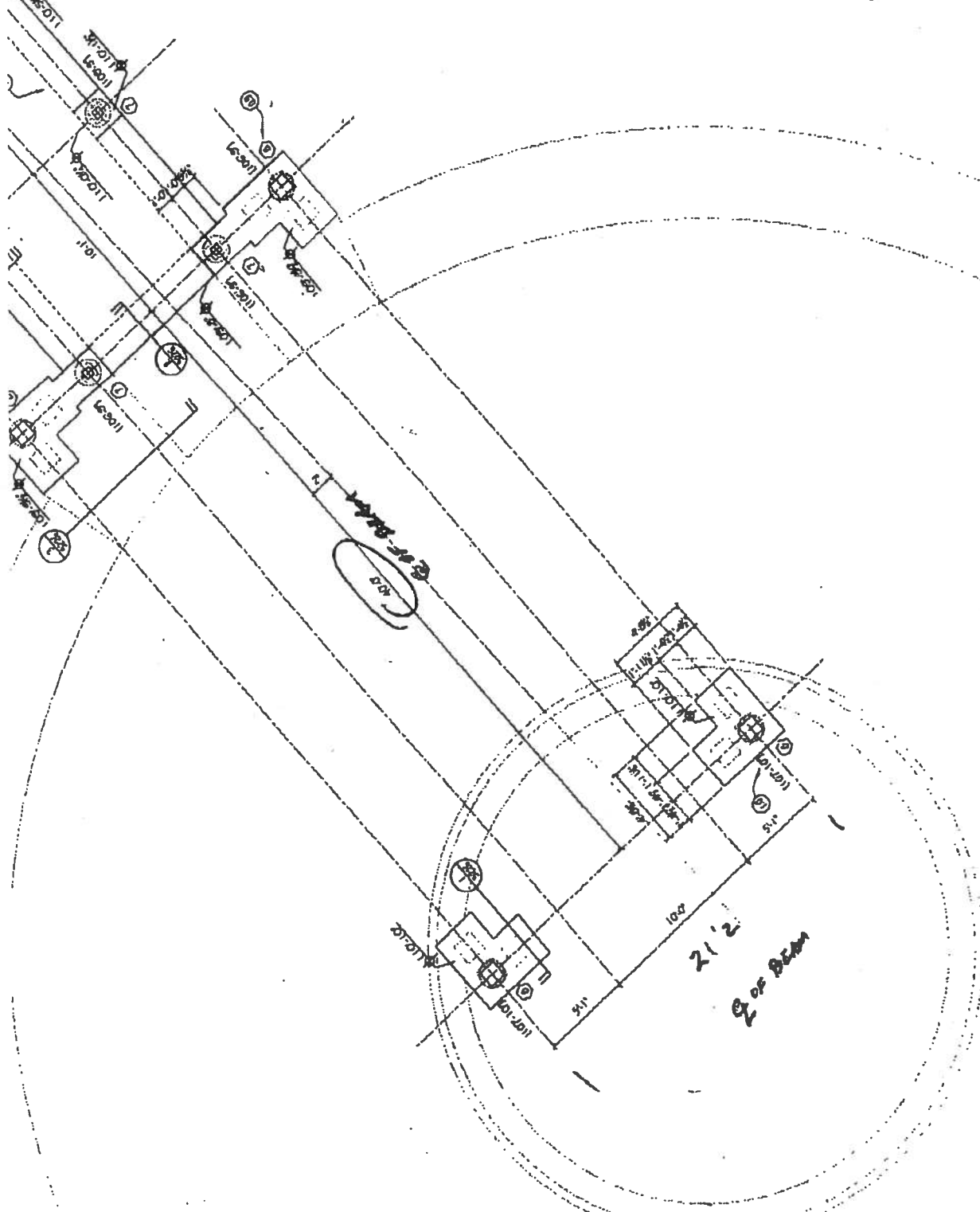
The request for a TR is not considered "filed for review" until the appropriate fee is received by the Division (as listed below by permit type). Please submit the appropriate fee with your request to expedite the review process. After the TR is submitted with the appropriate fee, the Division will determine if it is approvable within 30 days. If the Division requires additional information to approve a TR, you will be notified of specific deficiencies that will need to be addressed. If at the end of the 30 day review period there are still outstanding deficiencies, the Division must deny the TR unless the permittee requests additional time, in writing, to provide the required information.

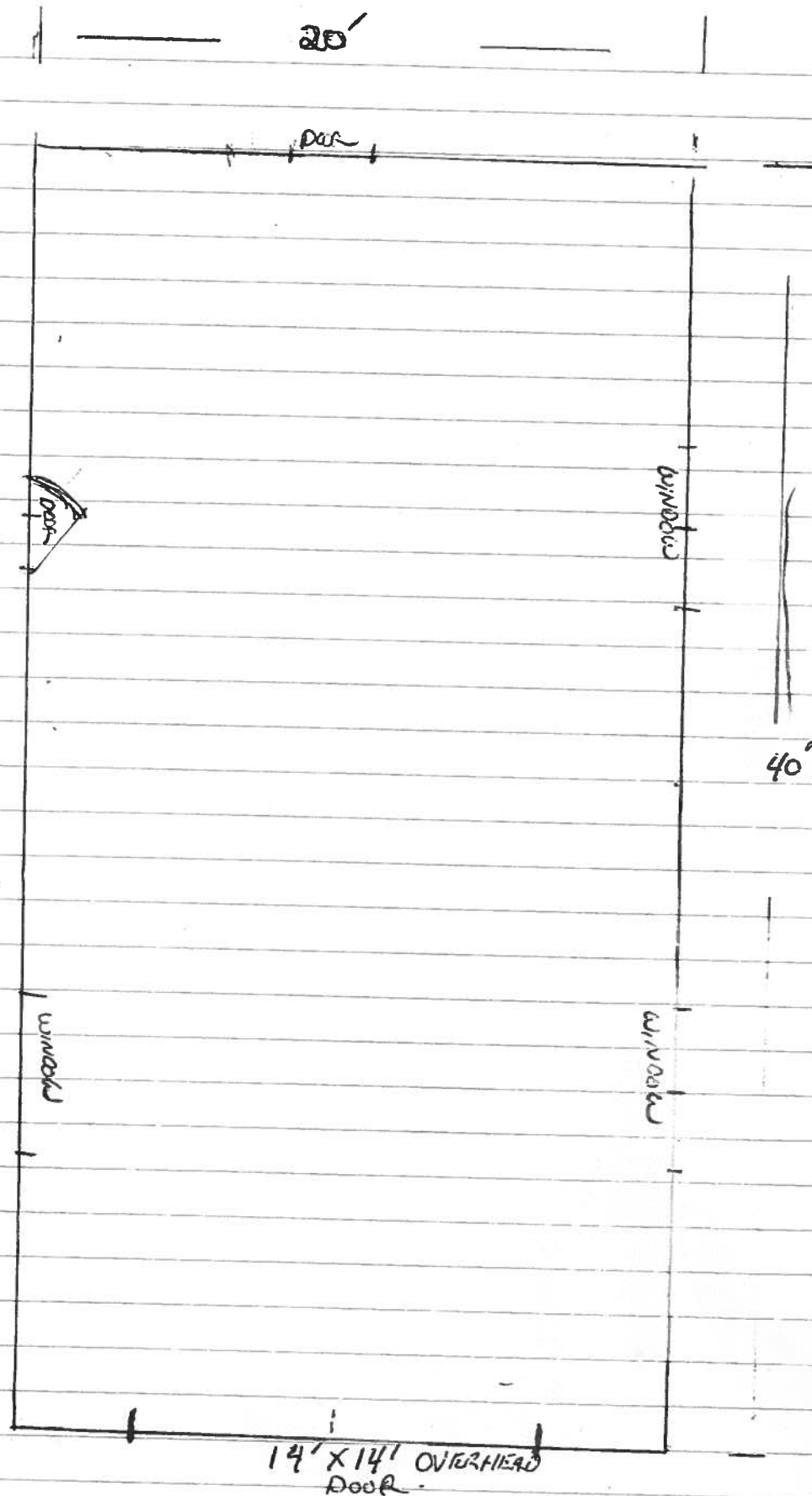
There is no pre-defined format for the submittal of a TR; however, it is up to the permittee to provide sufficient information to the Division to approve the TR request, including updated mining and reclamation plan maps that accurately depict the changes proposed in the requested TR.

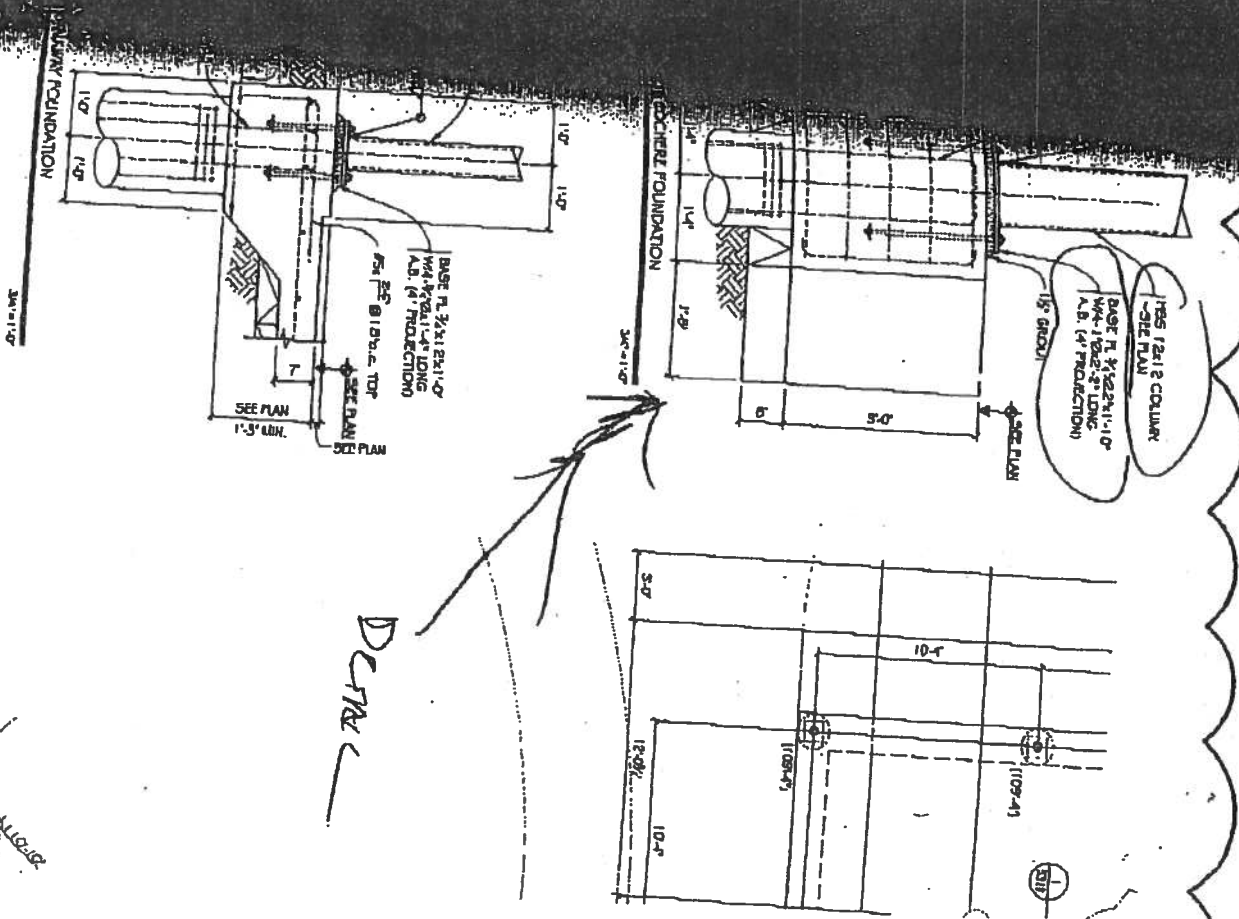

Estimated Cost to Remove Maintenance Building for Gillette Pit

- * One 4 cubic yard loader to demolish building and load onto semi Dump Trucks
 - * 6 hours @ \$125 per hour = \$750
- * One semi end dump 2 loads to transport 6 ton steel building off site.
 - * 8 hours @ \$85 per hour = \$680
- * One 4 cubic yard loader to break up & load 4cy concrete piers and 14cy slab.
 - * 5 hours @ \$85 per hour = \$425
- * One semi truck to haul concrete rubble to Colorado Springs and dump
 - * 8 hours @ \$85 per hour = \$680

Total cost before recycling \$2535.00

- * Credit for recycling scrape steel on building
 - * 6 tons @ \$225 per ton = <\$1350.00>

Total Estimated Cost for removal = \$1185.00
