Please be advised that on February 11, 2014, O'Rourke Excavating, Inc., whose address and telephone number are 2489 CR 15, South Fork, CO 81154; (719) 580-9602, filed an application to conduct Surface extraction of construction materials and reclamation, at or near Section 27, Township 40N, Range 4E, 10th Principle Meridian, in Rio Grande County. Please be advised that the permit area may be located in more than one Section, Township, and Range. The application decision is scheduled for March 13, 2014.

A copy of the application is available for review, unless you receive a CD, at the Rio Grande County Clerk & Recorder's office and at the office of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety, Room 215, 1313 Sherman Street, Denver, Colorado 80203.

If you desire to make comments or objections of the mine plan and/or reclamation plan, they must be submitted within ten (10) days of the date of the newspaper public notice to be considered in the application review process by the Division. You should contact the applicant for the newspaper publication date. If we do not receive your comments or any objection by the end of the public comment period, the Office will assume that you have no objection or comment to the proposed activity.
