The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has received a revision for the Bowie No. 1 Mine. The revision was deemed complete on February 14, 2014. The decision due date is April 15, 2014.

Bowie Resources, LLC is requesting that the requirement for subsidence monitoring at the Bowie No. 1 Mine above the Pitkin Mesa Pipeline be suspended. Mining was performed under the water line in 1992 and 1993. Seven subsidence monuments have been monitored since 1992. The monuments are located on private surface land.
