**Re: Bowie No. 1 Mine (Permit No. C-1981-038)
Technical Revision No. 57 (TR-57)
Suspend Subsidence Monitoring.**

Dear Sir or Madam:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety hereby issues notice, in accordance with Title 34, Article 33, Section 116, Paragraph 4, of the Colorado Revised Statutes, that on February 14, 2014 an application to revise coal mining operations at the Bowie No. 1 Mine was considered complete for the purposes of filing. The revision was submitted by Bowie Resources, LLC. All review and comment periods as provided in the Act and the Regulations initiate from this date of filing.

Bowie Resources, LLC is requesting that the requirement for subsidence monitoring at the Bowie No. 1 Mine above the Pitkin Mesa Pipeline be suspended. Mining was performed under the water line in 1992 and 1993. Seven subsidence monuments have been monitored since 1992. The monuments are located on private surface land.

The Underground coal mining operation is on land located approximately 3 miles North of Paonia. The permit area is further described as follows:
