Thank you for sending the Drainage Report and the opportunity to comment. The new plan appears to alter some on-site grading and layout but to have similar off-site effects as the previous plan.

Thus, the County has no concerns with the overall concept presented. Our only concern is that the new Drainage Report have similar substance to the first drainage report, which would include a delineation of sub-basins, TR-55 hydrologic calculations, storage calculations for the 4.8 AF of storage and the 220 AF of storage, adequate topo to show that the 220 AF indicated will actually exist, and show swales B and C (if they still exist, as indicated in the new report).
