CONDITIONS FOR APPROVAL

- If stormwater is contained on-site, it must infiltrate into the ground or be released to the natural stream system within 72 hours, or all work must cease until a substitute water supply plan, or augmentation plan approved by water court, is obtained.
- The proposed operation will consume ground water by: evaporation, dust control, reclamation, water removed in the mined product, processing, other:.
- This pit is registered under well permit no. 45537-F and is covered under an augmentation plan decreed by the Division 3 Water Court in case no. 96CW3. The conditions of well permit no. 45537-F and case no. 96CW3 shall be complied with.
