The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has received an application for the above mentioned permitting action for the West Elk Mine. The application was deemed complete on March 7, 2014.

The Mountain Coal Company, LLC has submitted an application for a Phase III Bond Release for the West Elk Mine. A Phase III Bond Release is a final bond release and termination of the Division's jurisdiction for the areas requested.
