Dear Sir or Madam:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has received an application for the above mentioned permitting action for the West Elk Mine. The application was deemed complete on March 7, 2014.

The Mountain Coal Company, LLC has submitted an application for a Phase III Bond Release for the West Elk Mine. A Phase III Bond Release is a final bond release and termination of the Division's jurisdiction for the areas requested. The proposed release is for the Lone Pine area, the Thermal Event area and the West Point area. The proposed release areas cover approximately 24.2 acres. Since this is a bond release, there will be a decrease in the mine's reclamation liability. The amount of the liability release will be determined following an application review and the bond release inspection.
