- The Division requires the Operator/Applicant's name to remain consistent and match the exact name registered with the Secretary of State's office throughout the application. After a records search of the business database on the Secretary of State's webpage, MMM Partnership could not be located as a registered business. Please register MMM Partnership through the Secretary of State's office; the office's webpage is <u>http://www.sos.state.co.us/</u>.
- 2. The Division requires the Applicant to provide documentation giving the signer the authority to sign on behalf of the company. The authorization document may be in the form of by-laws, resolution, affidavit signed by corporate secretary, certified secretary statement or a notarized statement on company letterhead.
- 3. The conversion application was submitted by Randy Schafer on behalf of MMM Partnership. Please provide a signed authorization letter for Randy Schafer to perform work and submit material for the MMM Partnership Gravel Pit on behalf of MMM Partnership.

You have sixty (60) days from the incompleteness date to submit all necessary documents the Office needs for an application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the sixty day period, the application has not been determined to be filed with the Office, the Office shall deny the application and terminate the application file.

The response due date is May 12, 2014.

This letter shall not be interpreted to mean that there are no other technical deficiencies in your application. The Division will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
