- 1. Please provide a revised Proposed Public Notice that includes the following:
- The public notice shall include a concise statement describing the particular portion of the road which is located within 100 feet, measured horizontally, of the affected area.
- The public notice does not include a statement that a copy of the Permit Revision will be on file at the Hayden Public Library during the public review process as per PAP page, 2.03-21.
- 2. Proposed page 2.05-105A states that, SubTerra Inc. conducted an additional subsidence survey to predict the potential for subsidence resulting from mining the initial six panels at PSCM s part of the expansion for longwall mining. The report of this survey, entitled "Peabody Sage Creek Mine Subsidence", PR01-2013, November 26, 2012 may be found in Exhibit 2.05.6-E4. This report was not attached with the PR-1 submittal. In order to conduct a review of the information provided which is based on the above mentioned report; please submit the referenced report for review by the Division
