The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety hereby issues notice, in accordance with Title 34, Article 33, Section 118, Paragraph 3, of the Colorado Revised Statutes, that on March 28, 2014, an application to revise coal mining operations at the Bowie No. 1 Mine was considered complete for the purposes of filing. All review and comment periods as provided in the Act and the Regulations initiate from this date of filing.

Bowie Resources, LLC is requesting approval to remove sediment ponds and alternate sedimentation control structures at the west mine and run-of-mine areas of the Bowie No. 1 Mine.

The Underground coal mining operation is on land located approximately 3 miles North of Paonia. The permit area is further described as follows:
