The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety hereby issues notice, in accordance with Title 34, Article 33, Section 116, Paragraph 4, of the Colorado Revised Statutes, that on March 31, 2014 an application to revise coal mining operations at the New Horizon Mine was considered complete for the purposes of filing. The revision was submitted by Western Fuels-Colorado, LLC. All review and comment periods as provided in the Act and the Regulations initiate from this date of filing.

TR-63 includes a design for a trench drain to intercept spoil water and route it around prime farmland near Pond 013.

The Surface coal mining operation is on land located approximately 1.7 miles Northwest of Nucla, Colorado. The permit area is further described as follows:

1.7 miles northwest of the Town of Nucla

The above-mentioned tracts of land are shown on the following USGS 7.5 minute Quadrangle map(s): Nucla.

The applicant is required to publish notice in a local newspaper that this application has been deemed complete. At the time of publication of this notice, the applicant is additionally required to place a copy of this application at the Montrose County Courthouse, 300 Main Street, Nucla, CO 81424, and at the Division office.
