INSPECTION TOPIC: Hydrologic Balance

PROBLEM/POSSIBLE VIOLATION: Problem: The liners below the fuel and oil tanks at the site are missing, putting the surface and gorundwater at risk of being contaminated in the event of a leak or spill. **CORRECTIVE ACTIONS:** Replace the liners below the fuel tanks and place the oil tank into secondary containment prior to the noted deadline date and submit photos to the Division as evidence of completion of the corrective actions.

OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety monitoring program. The condition of the site is similar to what it was at the time of the previous inspection conducted in 2009. The disturbance is limited to the processing area and the island constructed into the pond. The remainder of mining and reclamation activities at the site consist of processing and exporting the material currently piled along the perimeter of the island, exporting the remaining stockpiles and revegetating that areas that are to be revegetated, plus removal of the remaining mining equipment. Therefore reclamation activities necessary to complete activity at the site are minimal and the current bond amount is adequate.

During this inspection it was observed that the liners are missing beneath the two fuel tanks and the one oil tank. These must be replaced prior to using these tanks for storage, to prevent the possibility of a leak or spill. This is essential due to the location of these tanks, immediately adjacent to the pond.

Reclamation at the remainder of the site is exceptional. The armored banks of the pond appear stable and attractive. The reclamation along the creek is well designed. The overall site is outstanding and should be nominated for a reclamation award at the completion of reclamation.
