This letter, as required by Rule 3.03.2(4)(b) of the Rules and Regulations, is to inform you that the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has issued a proposed decision to Approve Surety Increase No. 1 for the Keenesburg Strip Mine. This decision will be published in the *Fort Lupton Press* as soon as possible. Publication of the notice initiates a thirty (30) day public comment period. If, within thirty days, there are no requests for an adjudicatory hearing, the decision will become final.

The bond for the operation is a Corporate Surety issued by your company (Bond No. 103799990), in the amount of \$1,937,676.00. The proposed increase amount is \$103,447.84.

Please be aware that this notification is not a request to initiate any action by Travelers Casualty and Surety Co of America concerning Bond No. 103799990, and is for your information only. Should Coors Energy Company choose to take action with regard to this bond increase, they will contact you.
