Dear Sir or Madam:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has received an application for the above referenced permitting action for the Bowie No. 2 Mine. The application was deemed complete on April 14, 2014.

Bowie Resources, LLC (BRL) is proposing to install two 18" flumes along the West Fork of Terror Creek to accurately measure stream flow. The flumes will be located outside of the current DRMS permit area, but will be used to provide data required by the DRMS permit under proposed Permit Revision No. 14. Minimal disturbance is proposed, and BRL will post additional reclamation performance bond for the disturbance.
