On April 24, 2014, this office received notification of the approval of your Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (CDRMS) application SL-01 for your Club Mesa mining notice / Notice of Intent (NOI) project (BLM case file # COC – 70978, CDRMS permit # P-2008-018) which effectively releases the reclamation bond of \$5,745.00.

We have concurred with the CDRMS's inspection report findings regarding reclamation and bond release. Therefore, the mining notice is determined to be completed in full compliance with federal surface management regulations found at 43 CFR 3809, and the case file is therefore closed.
