Re: Southfield Mine (Permit No. C-1981-014) Technical Revision No. 41 (TR-41) Request - Relocate Vegetation Reference Area.

Dear Mr. Patterson:

We have received your application for a technical revision to your permit to conduct coal mining in Colorado. Our initial review indicates that all preliminary items required by Rule 2.08.4(5) have not been submitted. Thus, your application is incomplete for the purposes of filing as of May 2, 2014.

Energy Fuels Coal Inc. failed to provide supporting information to demonstrate requirements of Rule 4.15.7(3)(a), (b), and (c), Rule 4.15.7(4)(a). Please provide supporting documentation of how the proposed loadout reference area compares to the previously approved reference area or the predisturbance area vegetation.

Map 2 shows Daniel Adamic as the surface landowner and Rocky Mountain Fuel as the mineral owner of the property being proposed for the load out reference area. EFCI failed to provide information from these landowners that the use of this parcel is acceptable. EFCI provided a letter from Rock and Rail LLC. The Division has no record of Rock and Rail LLC as a Surface or Mineral owner on the loadout or adjacent property.

In accordance with Rule 2.07.3(1), you have the opportunity to amend, review, or otherwise make your application complete.
