## Re: Proposed Decision Permit Renewal Application No. 4 (RN-4) Carbon Junction Mine (Permit No. C-1992-080)

Dear La Plata County Commissioners:

This letter is to inform you that the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety is proposing to approve a renewal application for a coal mining and reclamation permit. The application was submitted by Oakridge Energy, Inc. on January 23, 2013, for the Carbon Junction Mine.

Any person with an interest which may be adversely affected by the proposed decision may request a formal hearing before the Mined Land Reclamation Board within 30 days of the first publication of this notice by the Division in the *Durango Herald*.

The surface mine is located approximately 2 miles Southeast of Durango, Colorado. The permit area is further described as follows:

Portions of Section 4, Township 34 North, Range 9 West; Section 33, Township 34 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> North, Range 9 West; and Section 33, Township 35 North, Range 9 West.
