NOTICE OF PROPOSED DECISION

The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety proposes to approve Technical Revision Application No. 132 (TR-132) for the West Elk Mine (Permit No. C-1980-007), submitted by Mountain Coal Company, LLC. The Mountain Coal Company, LLC has submitted a Technical Revision to the West Elk Mine's permit. This revision proposes to change the location of several drill pads and light-use roads for the methane drainage wells in longwall panel E5. The original pad and road locations were approved in Permit Revision 14. This revision proposes to decrease the drill pad disturbance by approximately 7.0 acres and decrease the road disturbance by approximately 0.1 acres. There will be no change in the mine's permit boundary but there will be a change in the mine's disturbance boundary as a result of this revision. There will also be a change in the mine's reclamation liability, which will be calculated by the Division following any technical adequacy issues.

The West Elk Mine is a/an underground coal mine located in Delta, Gunnison County, approximately 9 miles E of Paonia, Colorado. Coal interest is federal and private, and the surface affected is federal and private land. The permit area encompasses approximately 17,154.90 acres.

This proposed decision is based on a finding that the proposed operation will comply with all requirements of the Colorado Surface Coal Mining Reclamation Act, Section 34-33-101, *et seq.*, C.R.S., and the regulations promulgated thereunder.

Copies of the proposed decision, including stipulations, are on file for public inspection at the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety, Room 215, Centennial Building, 1313 Sherman Street, Denver, Colorado 80203. Persons with an interest that may be adversely affected by the proposed decision may request a formal hearing before the Mined Land Reclamation Board on the proposed decision. Such request must be made within ten (10) days of the initial publication of this notice, must be in writing, and must state with reasonable specificity the reasons for the request and the objections to the proposed decision.
