### **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. A representative for the Operator was not present. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The Tellier Gravel Pit is located approximately 5.6 miles west of Steamboat Springs and accessed from CR33a. The site is a 112c operation that includes a total of 25 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$80,000.00 for this site. The Division has reviewed the reclamation costs and determined that the current financial warranty amount is adequate.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site.

The affected area was marked by posts that were clearly visible and adequate to delineate the affected area boundary.

This site is active, although mining was not occurring during this inspection. Much of the mined slopes have been adequately graded and vegetated. The active mining face, located in the south end of the permit area, is approximately fifteen feet in height and near vertical. The pit floor includes approximately six acres. Various materials stockpiles are located throughout the pit area.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
