OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. Rick Domson, representing the Operator, was present during this inspection. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The Frentress Gravel Pit is located approximately 3.5 miles southwest of Hayden and accessed from CR65. The site is a 110c operation that includes a total of 9.9 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$28,500.00 for this site. The Division has reviewed the reclamation costs and determined that the current financial warranty amount is adequate.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site.

The affected area was marked by t-posts that were clearly visible and adequate to delineate the affected area boundary.

The scale and scalehouse have been constructed at the entrance to the access road.

The site is active. Mining commenced in the west part of the permit area and is progressing to the east. Various materials stockpiles are located on the pit floor in the west part of the permit area. Approximately four acres are currently disturbed.

Fuels or other chemicals are not stored on site.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
