The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has received an application for the above referenced permitting action for the West Elk Mine. The application was deemed complete on May 23, 2014.

The Mountain Coal Company, LLC has submitted a Minor Revision to the West Elk Permit. The revision updates Map 51 - E-Seam Projected Operations to show mined-out areas. The map also corrects the location of the southern most mains, which were moved slightly to avoid a fault. There will be no changes to the mine's permit boundary or its affected or disturbed acreages. There will be no change in the mine's reclamation liability as a result of this revision. The applicant is not proposing additional surface disturbance outside of the area currently approved for disturbance.
