The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has received the above referenced Prospecting Notice of Intent release request. The request appears to meet the requirements of Rule 4.16.1. The site was inspected May 28, 2014 and all locations were considered adequately reclaimed. Due to the prospecting area being located on B.L.M. land, the Division requires a letter of concurrence from the Grand Junction B.L.M. Field Office. As of today May 29, 2014, the Division is informing Energy Fuels that SL-01 is approved. The bond will be released once the letter of concurrence is received from the BLM.

Per Rule 4.16.1 (4), the financial warranty shall not be held for more than sixty (60) calendar days after the Division finds that the Notice of Intent operator has successfully completed reclamation.
