OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the normal monitoring program established by the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division). The focus of the inspection was to determine the success of reclamation and determine if Energy Fuels could be released from reclamation liability. Energy Fuels representative Race Fisher and Todd Eldredge accompanied the DRMS during the inspection.

The NOI permitted the drilling of 14 exploration holes with only 11 actually being drilled. The majority of the holes inspected during the inspection were drilled on existing roads and were drilled and Plugged and abandoned in September 2012. Only one hole required the construction of 100 feet of new road. Adequate vegetation was observed at all observed drill sites and the newly constructed road. No open holes or piles of drill cuttings were observed.

The reclamation observed on May 28, 2014 was adequate for release. The Division will issue a release approval under separate cover.
