Dear Sir or Madam:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has received an application for the above referenced permitting action for the West Elk Mine. The application was deemed complete on June 9, 2014.

The Mountain Coal Company, LLC has submitted a Minor Revision for the West Elk Mine. The revision proposes to remove an additional 183 feet of the half-culvert ditch at the RPEE and replace it with a clay-lined, riprapped ditch. This is the same as Minor Revision 401, which was approved to replace a lower portion of this culvert with the same clay-lined, riprapped ditch. There will be no changes to the mine's permitted, affected or disturbed boundaries as a result of this revision. There will be no change in the mine's reclamation liability as a result of this revision. The applicant is not proposing additional surface disturbance outside of the area currently approved for disturbance.
