Dear Mr. Laroche:

On July 7, 2014 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received your email and photos regarding the corrective action cited in the Division's December 3, 2013 inspection report. Based on the information provided in your email the Division believes that the Operator has resolved the problem cited in the inspection report for sediment control. However, the Division has two follow-up questions regarding the removal of the stockpile:

- 1. It is the Division's understanding that the Operator may revise the final topography from what was previously approved in AM-03. The approved reclamation plan indicated that the phase 2 stockpile area would be used for extracting backfill material or left at original grade. Please provide the Division with a final grading plan if changes are made after the Operator revises the Storm Water Permit. If the Operator deviates from the approved reclamation plan the permit will need to be revised, to reflect the proposed changes to the final topography.
- 2. How does the Operator plan to stabilize the phase 2 stockpile area to prevent further wind and water erosion?
