Dear Mr. Burkey:

On July 30, 2014, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety reviewed the United Companies request for a 112 Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Technical Revision for the 15 Road Gravel Pit, Permit No. M-2002-114. Preliminary review of the information received determined that the following items must be addressed before the request can be approved:

- Please submit laboratory analysis of the Class A biosolids that are proposed to be imported and used for reclamation. Specifically, include heavy metals, pH, nitrate / nitrite and any other constituents that may be of concern.
- Per Rule 3.1.6, in the event that toxic materials were/are brought onto site what measures are to be implemented to protect the hydrologic balance of the affected land and the surrounding area?
- Please provide a detailed description of the contents of the "Class A" biosolids that will be used within the permit area. Provide the recommended application rate per acre and the proposed application method.
- Please provide the proposed rate of application and proposed application method for the Biosol.

This letter shall not be construed to mean that there are no other technical deficiencies in your request. The Division will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items. The decision date has been set for August 29, 2014. Please submit the requested materials on or before August 15, 2014 to allow Division staff time to review the submitted materials. If a request for an extension of the decision date or submittal of the requested materials is not received by August 15, 2014 the application may be denied.
