Dear Sir or Madam:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has received an application for the above referenced permitting action for the West Elk Mine. The application was deemed complete on August 1, 2014.

The Mountain Coal Company, LLC has submitted a Minor Revision to the West Elk Permit. The revision proposes to drill a maximum of six holes to investigate a possible location for a mine ventilation portal. The holes will be drilled along existing roads and on ground that was previously disturbed. There will be no increase in the mine's permitted, affected or disturbed boundaries as a result of this revision. There will be an increase in the mine's reclamation liability as a result of this revision. The applicant is not proposing additional surface disturbance outside of the area currently approved for disturbance.
