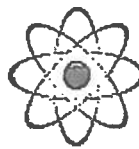

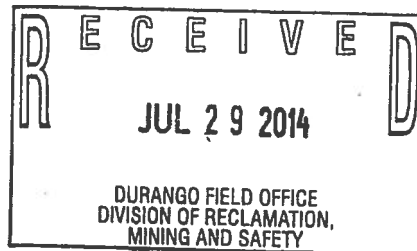

This letter is to acknowledge that the U.S. Department of Energy Office of Legacy Management (DOE-LM) received the subject document package on June 30, 2014. As you know from previous correspondence, "the U.S. District Court for the District of Colorado, in its Order of February 27, 2012, has enjoined DOE from approving any activities (including exploration, drilling, mining and reclamation) on lands governed by the Uranium Leasing Program." Accordingly, DOE-LM has decided to postpone the review of your submittal until the status of the Uranium Leasing Program (ULP) is fully resolved and the Court's injunction against DOE-LM and the ULP is dissolved.
