The Division has been reviewing the amendment application which contains the Environmental Protection Plan (EPP) for the Bulldog Mine operation. Due to the complex nature of the application, more time is needed to complete the review, and the Division must extend the decision date.

Pursuant to Hard Rock and Metals Rule 1.4.1(7), the Division may extend the decision date of a complex application by up to sixty days. The original decision date set by the Division for this application was August 25, 2014. The new decision date is now set for October 24, 2014.

The Division will provide you with its preliminary adequacy review letter soon, which will contain its questions and concerns that must be addressed.
