Dear Sir or Madam:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has received an application for the above referenced permitting action for the Bowie No. 2 Mine. The application was deemed complete on September 10, 2014.

Bowie Resources, LLC (BRL) is proposing to install two temporary culverts near Topsoil Stockpiles "D" and "E" to allow for equipment crossing during reclamation of Gob Piles #1 and #4. BRL has also requested relief from the requirement to pock the replaced topsoil on Gob Piles #1, #2, and #4. This will ensure that limited topsoil resources are not contaminated by subsoil material. The applicant is not proposing additional surface disturbance outside of the area currently approved for disturbance.
