The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has received an application for the above referenced permitting action for the Bowie No. 2 Mine. The application was deemed complete on September 18, 2014.

Bowie Resources, LLC (BRL) is proposing to designate a 2.1 acre refuse drying area at Gob Pile #3 in an area previously approved to be disturbed. The area will be used to store refuse material to allow it to dry before it is graded and compacted in accordance with the currently approved refuse disposal plan. The applicant is not proposing additional surface disturbance outside of the area currently approved for disturbance.
