Mr. Tibbetts,

The Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (Division) received your response on September 22, 2014 regarding the Problem(s) identified in the inspection conducted at the Kiowa Clay Mine on June 03, 2014. The status of the Corrective Action(s) associated with this Problem is as follows:

Corrective Action #1: The Operator shall, at the entrance of the mine site, post a sign which shall be clearly visible from the access road with the following: the name of the Operator, a statement that a reclamation permit for the operation has been issued by the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board, and the permit number. The Operator shall submit photo documentation that a proper sign has been posted by the corrective action due date.

The Operator submitted a photograph showing that a proper permit sign has been posted at the entrance to the mine. Therefore, this Problem is considered abated.
