Dear Sir or Madam:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has received an application for the above referenced permitting action for the Bowie No. 2 Mine. The application was deemed complete on September 25, 2014.

Bowie Resources, LLC (BRL) is proposing to install two temporary half culverts near Topsoil Stockpiles D and E to facilitate topsoil redistribution on Gob Pile #4. The culvert installation and topsoil redistribution will result in an additional 0.9 acres of new disturbance. The reclamation performance bond will be increased to cover the costs associated with culvert removal and reclamation of the new disturbance area. The applicant is proposing additional surface disturbance outside of the area currently approved for disturbance.
