We have received your application for a minor revision to your permit to conduct coal mining in Colorado. Our initial review indicates that all preliminary items required by Rule 2.08.4(5) have not been submitted. Thus, your application is incomplete for the purposes of filing as of September 30, 2014.

The application seeks to disturb an additional area at the south end of K and L pit by stripping the area of topsoil. However, the application form does not indicate there will be a change in the disturbed and affected area acres. Please submit an application form that indicates the amount of disturbed and affected area that will be added through this revision.
