The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has received an application for the above referenced permitting action for the Bowie No. 2 Mine. The application was deemed complete on October 9, 2014.

Bowie Resources, LLC (BRL) is proposing to replace an existing groundwater monitoring well that has failed with a well in the same water bearing zone at a new surface location. The drilling activities will disturb an additional 1.5 acres of new disturbance, and the reclamation performance bond will be increased to cover the costs of reclaiming the new well. The applicant is proposing additional surface disturbance outside of the area currently approved for disturbance.
