The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's Proposed Decision to approve with conditions Permit Renewal No. 6 at the Deserado Mine became final on October 21, 2014. Notice of the proposed decision was published in the *Rio Blanco Herald-Times* on September 18, 2014, initiating the thirty (30) day public comment period for the Division's decision. No requests for a formal hearing were received during the comment period.

Enclosed you will find two signed Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety Mining Permit documents. An authorized representative of Blue Mountain Energy, Inc needs to sign both documents and have them notarized. One must be returned to the Division at the above address; the other must be kept on file at the mine office.

Please be aware that issuance of the permit renewal will initiate time frames of any enclosed stipulations to the permit. Stipulations are enclosed in a rider to the permit, if any were imposed upon the permit. All other enclosed commitments are also in effect as of the permit issuance.
